

**Process:** Business Objects (BOBJ) Web Intelligence is used to display reports. Reports can contain data from databases, such as Business Warehouse, GRADS, HANA, PBF (Public Budget Formulation) etc. Reports can contain data tables, graphs, charts, and sub-reports. The following steps will show you the basics of changing the variables used to run a Business Objects (BOBJ) report by entering a new value.

## Basic Information


Required variables must have a value entered before the report will run.

Variables listed with ranges display with a **From** and **To** field. An entry must be made in both fields or you may pull more data than you intend. For example, if you enter the **Fiscal Year/Period From** 002/2015 with no **Fiscal Year/Period To** entry, you will pull data from August 2015 to the current date.

## Changing Variables

Use these steps to change report variables.


Open the Business Objects report by drilling down in the folders and double-clicking on the report.



<p>Click <b>Refresh Data</b></p>	<p>Upper left-hand corner</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Lower right-hand corner</p>
<p>A system message will display</p>	
<p>The Prompts window opens</p> <p>The available prompts are on the left-hand side of the window</p> <p>Select the prompt you want to change</p>	
<p>If there are no values shown on the right-hand side, select Refresh Values.</p>	


Select the value(s) you want and transfer it to the right-hand side.

Select OK to continue.




There are several ways to search for a value.

Double-click on the value



Single-click and select




to move the value to the right

Select OK to run the report




A system message will display
