Process: It is important to use the correct date when changing or adding a program of study, major, minor, option, specialty, and/or subspecialty. The information below will provide the appropriate date to use when you are making these changes.

Role: Authorized Personnel

Frequency: When Needed

Undergraduate Programs/Majors, Etc.

All undergraduate program, major, minor, option, specialty, sub-specialty changes **must have** an effective start date of the day of the change. The only exception to this policy is for those students who are changing into a fee-based program.
